Access to Domaine de Saint Paul

By Car:

From Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG): https://maps.app.goo.gl/KH7P2zbzsqCMJbQG8 (1h)

From Orly Airport (ORY): https://maps.app.goo.gl/qsRQsVc9M3qvvun6A (35-60 min)

- •From Paris, take the A10 motorway towards Chartres/Orléans. Exit at Les Ulis and follow signs for Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse.
- •The Domaine de Saint Paul is located on the Route de Limours (D988), at number 102.
- •Free parking is available on site.

General informations

TRANSPORTS: Paris has an extremely extensive public transport system, which usually works quite well. The main means of transport in Paris:

Paris Metro: The underground system has 14 interconnected lines and is also linked with the other RER trains.

The Paris RER: is a regional train transport system connecting the center to its surrounding suburbs.

RER A: Connects Disneyland Paris with the city centre.

RER B: Connects Charles de Gaulle Airport with the city centre.

RER C: Its destinations are Orly Airport and the Palace of Versailles

Paris city buses; One of the easiest and most convenient ways of getting around Paris is by bus. The buses in Paris https://www.ratp.fr/plan-bus


- **Transport Tickets** –There are different types of transport tickets available:
- •T+ Ticket: Single journey
- •Paris Visite: Multi-day travel card, ideal for short stays
- •Navigo: Weekly or monthly pass, convenient for longer stays

Tip: For participants attending a multi-day event, the Paris Visite card or Passe Navigo weekly pass is usually

the most convenient and cost-effective option, as it allows unlimited travel on public transport.

Access by train from airports


The Domaine Saint-Paul is easily accessible from the two airports and all railway stations:



- •From Orly Airport (ORY): 1h40min
- •Take Line 14 to Chatelet-Les Halles station
- •From Chatelet-Les Halles station, take the RER B towards Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse and exit to the terminus station.

From Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG) direct access: 2h

•Take the **RER B** directly from the airport towards *Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse* and exit to the terminus station.





Access by train from Paris

Prom Châtelet-Les Halles or Gare du Nord: RER B → Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse (terminus)

Other train stations: Metro connections to RER B

- Gare de Lyon / Saint-Lazare: Metro line 14 → Châtelet-Les Halles
- Gare Montparnasse: Metro line 6 → Denfert-Rochereau
- Gare de l'Est: Metro line 5 → Gare du Nord
- Gare d'Austerlitz: RER C → Saint-Michel → RER B
- •Take the **RER B**, continue to the *Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse* terminus station .
- •From the station, **## Hotel shuttle service:** Available for the duration of the symposium. Can be arranged in advance by contacting the hotel directly.
- Or from the Saint-Rémy-lès-Chevreuse terminus station, ♠ take a taxi (≈ 5 min)
- Or $\mbox{\ref{A}}$ walk 1,3Km (20–25 min) to Domaine de Saint Paul (access to the hotel for pedestrians).

RER B STATION to DOMAINE DE SAINT-PAUL : 1,3 km

After the entrance of the Domaine, turn right along «Le Pavillon» and follow the path downhill to the staircase.

Other information: France area code: +33; Paris area code: 01
